

What is the Thousand Home Challenge (1KHC)?

The 1KHC offers a new paradigm for reducing total energy use in existing North American homes. By redefining "deep energy reductions" and providing easily verifiable criteria, the Thousand Home Challenge provides a roadmap for homeowners, building professionals, and communities to develop integrated solutions to the problems of housing affordability, durability, and sustainability.

The 1Khc integrates technical, behavioral, and community solutions to deep energy reductions: The THC is unique in addressing the role of residents and communities in developing creative solutions to reducing home energy use – in conjunction with the more conventional enclosure upgrades, equipment efficiency, and renewable sources.

The 1KHC stimulates technical innovation: The bold nature and continental scope of the THC will help catalyze adoption of market-ready emerging technologies, and spur creation and development of new residential building products and components, assemblies, controls, and integrated systems.

The 1KHC supports development of skilled jobs and professional expertise: By creating regional collaboratives, the THC has the potential for accelerated deployment, including the opportunity to help develop a non-exportable green collar workforce.

The goal of the Thousand Home Challenge is to demonstrate the potential for reducing the total annual site energy consumption of existing North American homes by at least 70 percent. Such deep energy reductions are achieved by a combination of energy efficiency, renewable resources, behavioral choices, and community-based efforts.
